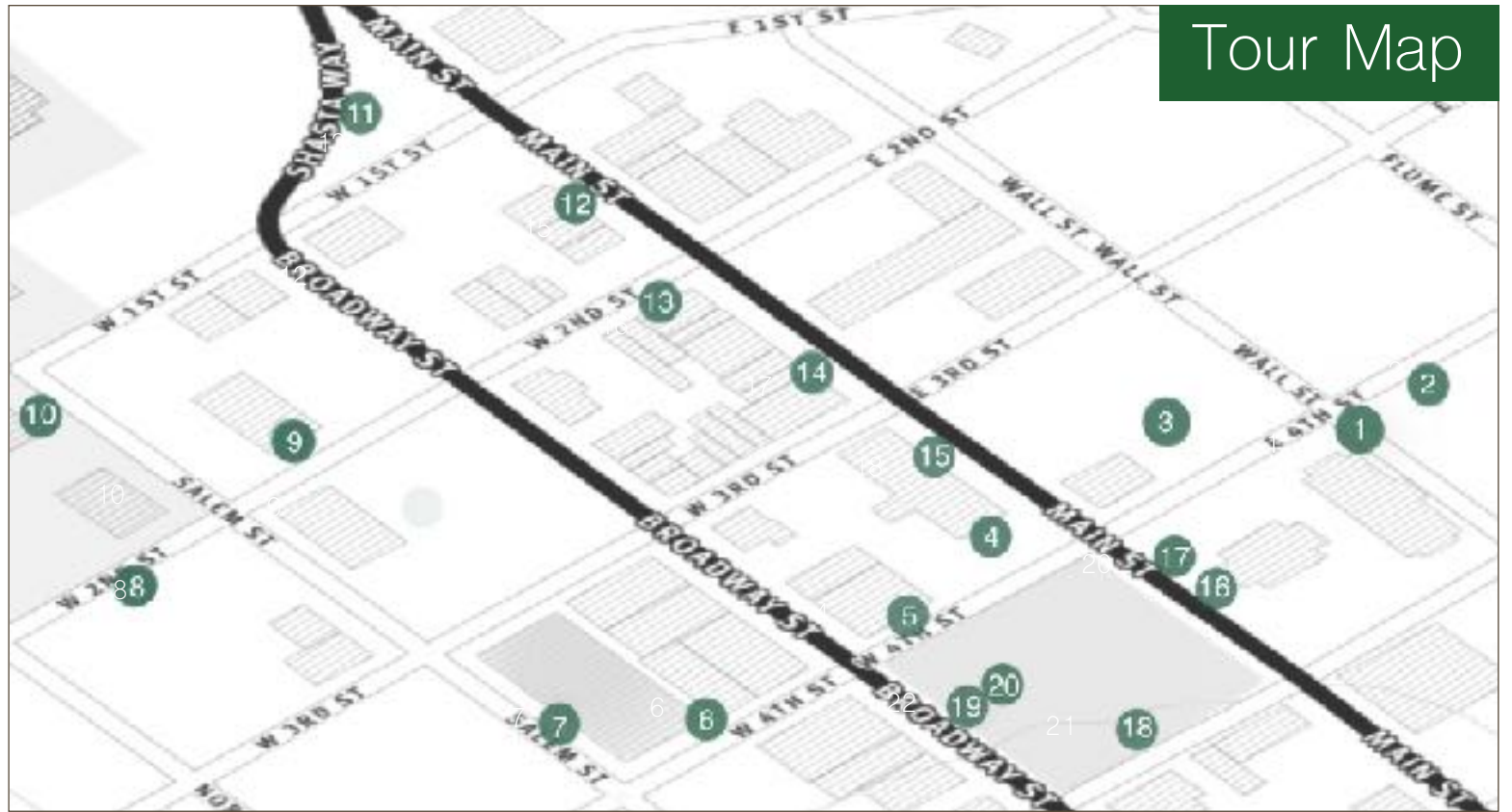
## Arts in chico:
